The Transition Blueprint!

The IEP meeting is over, but the work isn't done. June is the "Golden Window" for ensuring your child's fall success.

- The RAW Tip: Don't assume the new teacher in August will have memorized your child's 30-page file. Use June to create a "Student Snapshot"—a one-page "User Manual" for your child. Include their triggers, what motivates them, and the specific accommodations that were "game-changers" this past year.
- Action Step: Send this snapshot to the school principal or the incoming teacher now, before they head out for summer. It establishes you as a proactive partner and ensures your child's needs are front-of-mind before Day One.

The Reading Room (Literacy & Tutoring)

Books as Passports

When the pressure of grades is removed, we have a unique opportunity to repair a child's relationship with reading.

- **The Strategy:** Shift from "Required Reading" to "Joy Reading." If your student struggles with literacy, let them choose books based on their "obsessions" (Minecraft, space, graphic novels). The goal in June is volume, not just difficulty.
- **The Resource:** We are launching our "Summer Power Hour" this month. If you want your child to keep their skills sharp in a low-pressure, high-fun environment, now is the time to grab a spot.

The Educator's Edge (Teacher Consultation)

The Art of the Reset

To my fellow educators: Your brain deserves a break, but your "Teacher Heart" is likely already thinking about next year.

- **The Edge:** Instead of scrolling Pinterest for classroom decor, do a "Pedagogical Audit." Identify the one teaching method that felt like "swimming upstream" all year. Was it your small group rotation? Your data collection?
- **The Goal:** Use June to simply identify the problem. Don't solve it yet. Just acknowledge it. When we consult in July/August, we'll have the clarity to build a better system. For now, breathe.

The RAW Mindset (Empowerment)

Own Your Season

Empowerment looks different in June. It looks like setting boundaries and reclaiming your time.

- **Affirmation:** "I am allowed to rest. My value is not tied to my productivity, and my peace is a priority."
- **The Goal:** Set one "Non-Negotiable" for June. Maybe it's a morning walk, a tech-free hour, or finally starting that hobby you put on the shelf. You can't pour from an empty cup.

- **The Prompt:** What is the story you've been telling yourself you'll write "when things quiet down"? Guess what? Things just quieted down.
